






SENEC, SLOVAKIA

- Senec is situated in south-western part of the Slovak Republic, only 25 kilometers away from its Capital Bratislava on the main highway and railway path connecting Bratislava to the other parts of Slovakia and to the neighbouring countries)
- The nearest European metropolises are Vienna
 90 km, Budapest 230 km and Prague 350 km
- Town has currently about 18 000 inhabitants of predominantly Slovak and Hungarian nationalities and several other ethnic minorities
- Due to its proximity to Bratislava and as well as to the influence of modern migration tendencies, the number of its inhabitants is henceforth rapidly increasing.
- In 1996 Senec became a district town, its district today consists of 28 municipalities, total area 38,71 km²
- Mayor of Senec since 2002: Karol Kvál



- Development of the town is influenced by its location and as well as by the Sunny Lakes, which are one of the most visited summer destinations in Slovakia with about 900 000 visitors every year
- The town of Senec is in active cooperation with its foreign twin partners: the Austrian Parndorf, the Croatian Senj and the Hungarian Köszeg





The local Church of St. Nicholas has been mentioned in written reports as early as 1323 and it is at present the oldest and most dominant historical building in Senec



In 1574, Senec became the birthplace of Albert Molnár Szenczi, a Calvinist clergyman, poet, translator and an important representative of the Reformed education system (his statue is currently located in the park in Peace Square)



It was in Senec, where the empress Maria Theresa of Austria established the first college type of school with economic orientation in 1763. Senec also became an important administrative centre



From the 16th until the 18th century, the representatives of the Bratislava (then *Pozsony*) county used Senec as the location for their frequent sessions (meetings were held in our most precious monument known as Turkish House – renaissance castle, in which the Museum of the town is established)






During the period of 1787 – 1790 two textile manufactories were producing their products made of hemp fibre and tow (Big Stift – one of the biggest historical objects in the town, Maria Theresa has established here the reformatory for women in year 1773, where this women were working in these textile manufactories)

More preserved historical monuments: Column of Shame, Immaculata, Chapel of the Holy Trinity etc.







Thanks to its Sunny lakes (area 80 ha and deph max. 12 m), formed by continuous gravel excavations in connection with the construction of a railway system between cities Bratislava and Galanta in the second half of the 19th century, Senec is mainly known as a summer tourist centre.





In recent years, the appearance of the town centre changed significantly, particularly due to a reconstruction of the square





Short Overview on Economy of Senec

The main sources of city income are the contribution from government budget and the local taxes. For example, from estate taxes we received 2.923.358,- € in 2013. In the same year 1.378.590, -€ was invested to the city development.

The general estate of the town Senec was 55.409.000, - € in 2014. The local budget for 2015 consists of 3.703.652, - €. The city administration plans for every year a balanced budget. The investment planning is based on predicted permanent growth of population. It means that Senec has to devote most of his sources to extension of communal infrastructure:

- reconstruction and building roads, walkways, cycling paths, parking places
- building and reconstruction of nursery schools, primary schools, sport facilities, playgrounds
- development of social, cultural and health care services

In the technology of lighting of public places we achieved considerable development last year, when Senec became The LED Town of Year in Central and East Europe, after we replaced almost 90 % of public lights with LED technology lights.

Extension of Town's Sewerage Plant will be the most expensive project of near future. The town administration is now developing the project funding plan.


